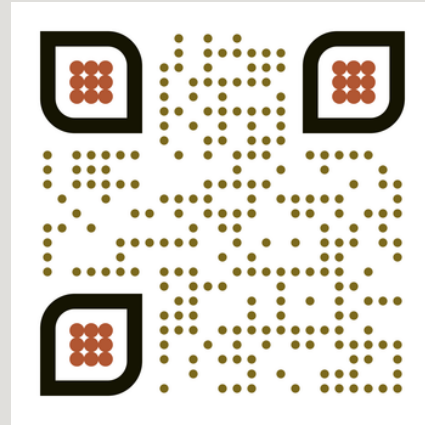
Goke Ode

OLABISI AKINJARE



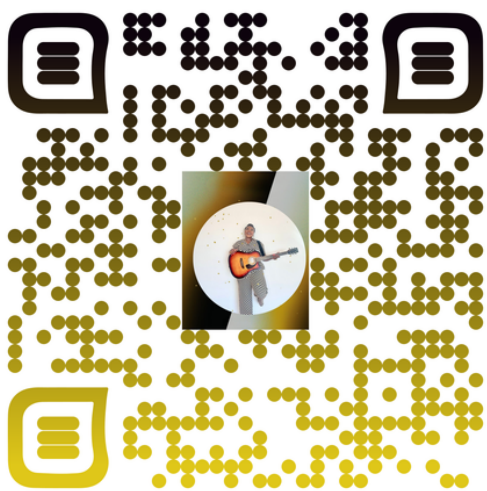

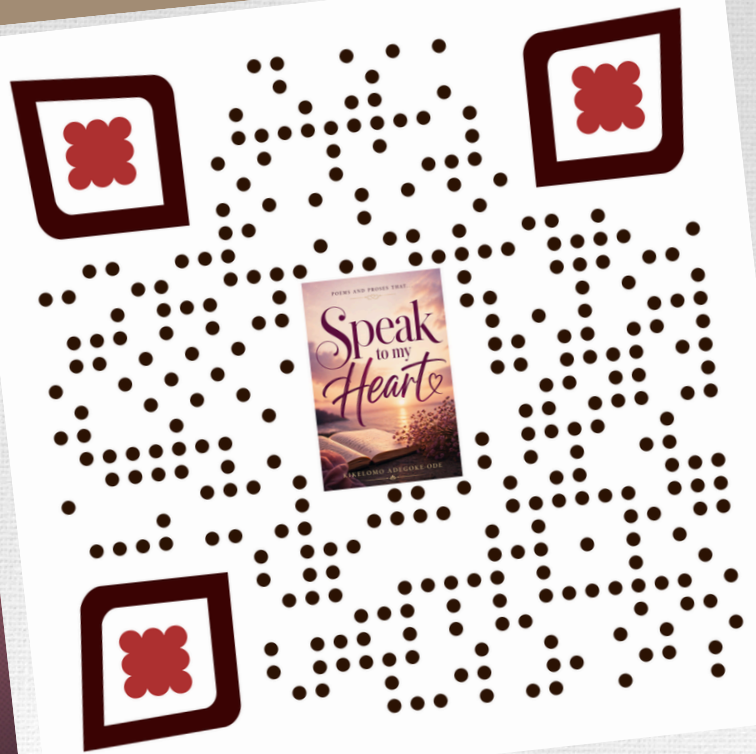


PRECIOUS PETERS

Kikelomo ADEGOKE-ODE



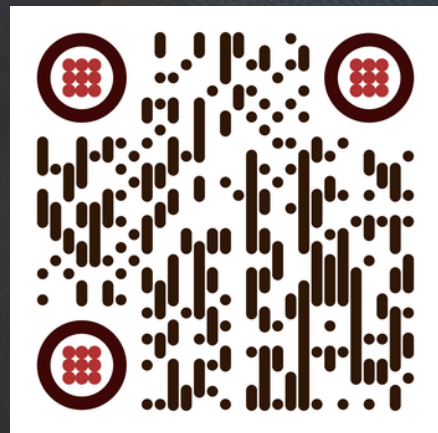
